Tom has been our States Attorney since 1991 and his office handles felony, juvenile, traffic and misdemeanor cases. Livingston County has three assistant States Attorneys who assist in prosecuting these cases. The office also has four secretaries, a victim/witness coordinator and a part time summons server.

His office also advises the county on legal matters. Due to space limitations, the States Attorney's Offices are located on all three floors of the court house. This is not the most efficient setup, but he and his staff make do with what they have. Tom told us about the Livingston County Pro-active Unit that he helped establish to fight the county's growing drug problem. This unit has been successful in its battle by turning up the heat on drug dealers and making them think twice about staying in our county.
