The Society was formed in 1998 by Deb Trainor & Karen Grady. Deb would board all the dogs and Karen the cats. Two and one half years ago they purchased a large barn (building) in Rowe. They are allowed to house 25 dogs and 25 cats, presently they have 34 or 35 cats. They are a not-for-profit organization consisting of around 50 volunteers. Mary is the one full-time staff member with four employees at 20/hours per week being paid. They get operation funds from donations, fundraisers and memorials. Dr. Schleder donates 10 hours per week for surgery. They have adopted out 177 cats and 264 dogs. They do this through their web site, ads and actually taking them out (like our Christmas parade). They will not take any aggressive dogs. They try to find foster homes for these pets. They have to be spayed or neutered before they allow them out. They also treat them for heartworm, etc. They find many cats with Leukemia and Aides. Their budget is around \$100,000. They charge \$65 to adopt a cat and \$110.00 for a dog. They are a low kill facility. Science Diet has made a deal for \$.25 per pound for cat and dog food. They will spend approx. \$75 on cats and \$100 for dogs for shots, etc.
