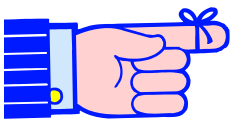

Scott Anderson, Jr.

Scott gave a very informative program on Rotary. Some highlights: He coached Bonnie Blair - he is an ice hockey ref. and trial lawyer. He joined Rotary in 1976. Scott is also Vice Chairman of the Multi-P.E.T.S.

Foundation was started with a \$2 million donation then. In 1989 women were admitted. We have 1.2 million Rotarians in 168 countries - 30,000 clubs and 530+ districts. Someone has to ask 1 person per year. We have great fellowship, great programs and activities. We stay because of our friendship. We are a group of caring people with a sense of involvement for the club and community. Our largest goal was to eradicate polio with \$240 million for vaccines, volunteer help, etc. Last year we were down to less than 1000 cases in the world. Rotary helps us feel better about ourselves. It is important that you ask people to join Rotary. They can't join if you don't ask. We started out "*Service Not Self*" and changed to "*Service Above Self*". In 1932 the 4-way test was established. In 1947 Paul Harris died. The Paul Harris
