Joyce explained several services that they supply. Home Health Care - Hospice - Home Medical Equipment - Personal Response System - Home Infusion Pharmacy - Diabetic Supplies - Health Watch & Medicine Dispensing.

Home Health is medicare certified for the home bound. They have to have a medical reason or skill problem. They can provide nursing, therapy (speech & physical) and social work. You have to be under a doctor's care and they have to address a need.

Hospice is for the terminally ill. They basically have 6 months or less to live. They are medicare certified. It can include cancer, heart, alzheimer's, kidney failure, N-stage of diabetic. They go by the medicare check list and provide medication and/or equipment.

They treat any age. Their training is based on their mission statement.

They do have a Chaplin and also many volunteers. This is a non-profit service.
