Dr. Trent D. Proehl, M.D.

Dr. Proehl first explained the path he followed to get his medical degree and told how he and his wife came to be at OSF in Pontiac. Dr. Proehl is a General Surgeon. He went on to explain what that means and how surgical procedures have improved in the last several years.
