The fund-raiser and renovation of the football stadium have gone well. The strength and conditioning center is done and is par with anyone else. It is the largest in Division One Football. Bits & Pieces

Tom Kite, former U.S. Open champion golfer, consults regularly with sport psychologist Dr. Bob Rotella. And in Kite's "Golf News & Notes" column, he reports a golf tip that golfers and nongolfers alike can apply off the course as well - in business and personal situations:

You can only play one hole at a time. That's the first step toward how to think like a pro. An important key to a successful game is staying in the present. Here are a few ways Doc and I recommend to help you focus on your game and keep you from getting ahead of yourself:

"Resist the urge to add it up. If you anticipate your score, you'll be distracted from the task at hand. Avoid thinking about

breaking a personal record or blowing a lead."

"Focus. Concentrate on hitting great shots rather than worrying about bad ones or what others will think if you miss. Visualize the ball going to your target. If your mind wanders, take a moment to refocus and start over again."

"Keep your mind on the hole you're playing. Don't worry about the shot you must miss, or how you're going to play the 18th. Taking care of the present lets the future take care of itself."
