Mike is a Fairbury native. He moved back about a year ago to the home place. He has been in law enforcement for 28 years+. He started in Rantoul for 2 years, then Bloomington. He thought he would wing it today on "Cyber Crime". He has spent 13 years in child

protection and 6 years in child molestation. It took its toll on him. It was a relief to get into gang suppression.

Six to seven years ago he became a detective on computer cyber crime. When they got into cyber crime they found it

would take two years to get a computer analyzed. So, they decided to do it on their own. After \$500,000, they had a computer lab. They are now the premier dept. in Illinois. With a computer, their jurisdictional bounds are worldwide. They had to go Federal to be able to enforce the law. They started FBI, then went Secret Service. His task force covers Bloomington, Peoria, Mattoon, Champaign, Quincy, a total of 18 counties.

A look at history . . . we started with a car, then radios, finger printing, D.N.A., and now cyber crime. This is new and they investigate it. Most police cannot investigate this crime. Child pornography and exploitation is fast and bad. They can and will steal your identify. You need to look into Life Lock, etc.
