FCCLA



This is the 6th year at P.C.H.S. for FCCLA. The first few years they had around 59 students. This year they are up to 122. Naomi, Brooke and Andrea presented their project, a scrapbook of their FCCLA activities.

Their scrapbook was Best in State. They will be going to Nationals in Chicago over July 4-8. Jeannea will be taking 7 students. P.C.H.S. FCCLA took 9 star events at state this year. Some things they do :

At Halloween they "trick or treated" for canned foods for the Chenoa Food Pantry. Once a month they make meals and sell them to the teachers and also cook for the Hospitality Rooms, like the Hawk Classic. They are involved in the state program - Recycling Going Green and received the top award of \$1,000. They taught the 5 R's and also participated in the Children's Miracle Network - each class made a paper chain with each link costing \$1 - all money went to the program. They had a blood drive with 100 people donating 92 pints to the Red Cross. They put on a style show after prom. They are going to have an FCCLA banquet next week and will also start an Alumni Association this year. Did you know 10-15% of the membership is made up of boys?
