Brooks Carey is the pitching coach. John showed us their new hats and shirts. The Cornbelters are part of the Frontier League which includes 6 states with 12 teams. They have two divisions and hand pick their players between the ages of 21 - 27.

This league gives the kids an opportunity to go on. They will play 96 games this year.

Admission rates will range from \$5 to \$11. The new stadium will house 4,000 for box seats and 3,000 in the outfield. They will have entertainment every night. Monday is Bingo Night;
