P.C. Elementary Schools

Trish said they went from 416 to 393 students. Westview, in the next five years has a potential of 12 teachers retiring. The unfunded mandates by the state and the time limits give them problems. Are we going to have to cut out "recess"? Can you imagine kids with no play time? They were RYC on the ISAT test. The Upper Elementary received the Blue Ribbon. They are one of only eighteen in the state. On the RTI, they were strong in reading and math. They will have new state common core standards.

Karen is over Meadowbrook and Chatsworth. They are pretty consistent student wise. The teachers enjoy their work and stay current. They do see a high transient rate of students.

With ISAT, they are a spotlight school. They have a high accounting (50% or more) low income families. Chatsworth did win the academic award. They have fewer paraprofessionals but have acquired a lot of new technology through ARA funding. This requires less staff. They have smart boards in all but one classroom. They also have an "anti-bullying program". "Be A Buddy, Not A Bully!" It is a positive program that is working.

Dan is in Chenoa. Their RTI tech program is going well. They tend to have a high mobility rate. A lot of students are moving in and out. Their test averages are higher than the state. They have 180 students with a high success rate on state tests.
