The end may be in sight". They just might be done in a month and a half. Outside, they have sidewalks, fascia and downspouts to finish. Inside, the electric is roughed in, plumbing to finish, heat, etc. They have primer on the east side walls. Second floor, they have the drop ceilings in and sprinkler systems both wet and dry. It is 75% paid for. Money is short. Some pledge money is not available for a year away.

Currently, they are around \$80,000 short. This is why the letter was sent out. They are in need of metal adjustable shelving at \$44,000. They run \$450 for children and \$550 for adult. They had to refinish the front desk. They have worked well with the contractor with not too many problems. The specs were pretty reasonable. They will be doing the community room but not the kitchen part - too many regulations. It would cost them \$50,000 just for a warming kitchen. They did stub in the utilities for the kitchen. They are creating a book for donations to the library to remain there with certain level givings. The school will be doing the landscaping.
