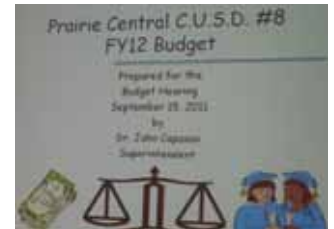
Prairie Central Budget
