"Age of Shale" Has Arrived: Shale is rocking the U.S. energy industry to its core. This technique of cracking open shale rock to release

oil and natural gas has spurred hundreds of billions of dollars worth of deals. Jerry will also explain how **"Genecor Trailers - Hydraulic fracturing**, commonly referred to as fracking, is a proven technology advancement which allows producers to safely recover natural gas and oil from deep shale formations.
